



ROLF GROUP OPENS ONE OF THE LARGEST TOYOTA DEALERSHIPS IN EUROPE

Moscow 18 October 2010: The ROLF Group, Russia's leading automotive business, has opened its first Toyota dealership, bringing to 10 the number of international auto brands represented by the Company.

The new dealership, the construction of which restarted in second half 2009 as the Russian market for new car sales saw signs of rebounding from crisis-levels, extends to 13,161 square metres, including 1,700 square metres of sales area, 72 service bays for general repair works and full body shop services as well as a 1,000 square metre 2-level parts warehouse. Some 100 staff are employed at the dealership which is expected to sell more than 1500 cars in 2011.

ROLF has invested some \$100 million in land acquisition and build costs on the site at Km39 of Moscow's principal ring road. ROLF's first Lexus dealership will open adjacent to Toyota in the 1st half of 2011.

Speaking at the official opening of the new dealership, Nick Hawkins, ROLF's Chief Executive Officer said "This grand opening is the first large-scale project for ROLF after the crisis and is a very important symbol of our further development. The combination of the ROLF and Toyota brand images and client service standards will serve to reinforce our leadership in a market that is clearly showing signs of growth".
